Martin Pedersen DK

For his living Kurt is a KTM dealer in Aarhus since ~20 years.

He started riding motocross when he was 17 years old, and did that for 3-4 years. Later on he continued with Road Racing for 4-5 years.

He rides Classic motocross since 2000 - began on a CZ, but since 4 years now he rides on a BSA Victor.

Plans for 2012: Try to repeat the victory in the JST 50+ class, "I believe the competition will be harder with more fast riders in 2012, but I will do my very best to beat them". "I will also do my best to improve my position from 2011 in the ECMO CEC 50+ class" Kurt said.

Champion Open Age (L.h. side)

Flemming Vad DK

Born in 1966, lives in a family house, with a, for Flemming, important work shop in Hadsund DK.

Family Mama, Papa and a sister. He is educated motorbike mechanic but works, since 10 years now, as an air condition/heat pump service technician.

Flemming has been riding motocross since he was 8 years old – started on a modified 50cc Everton and has been riding motocross ever since. He represented Denmark in the MCdN in 1985. 1987 –91 he made some attempts to qualify to World Championship races. He started riding classic motocross, on papa Børge's BSA Victor, after that papa had an accident in Dieskau 2006 resulting severe back/neck injuries. Luckily papa got recovered and came back riding motocross, which resulted in that Flemming had to buy his own motorbike, a BSA Victor as well.

For his practice he rides his Honda 250cc minimum once a week during the winter/spring time.

Flemming is, like papa Børge, a "bringer of happiness" outside the race track – there is always some jokes going on around them!

Plans for 2012: to defend my JST title and to improve my third place in the ECMO CEC 35+.
