The annual international CEMAR AGM was held in Gremersdorf, Germany, November 19, 2016.

#### General

- Committee members: Some changes see "CEMAR Committee Members" on www.classicmx.se
- Penalty points: Re-implementation of the option for the Jury to allow a rider to participate in a class with non-approved parts by giving penalty points.
- Number plate colours and numbers <u>must be</u> according to the rules. 3 penalty per leg for wrong number plate colours. If wrong colours for second Cemar race means no start.
- Cups will no longer be given to the best 125cc, best 60+ and best 66 + riders but best 70+ rider will still get a cup.
- Laurels will no longer be given to the winner but a nice large trophy will be given.
- Helmets to be FIM approved.
- Entry fee for 2017 Euro 50 for a day event and Euro 75 for two day event.
- Camping pit to be kept open from Friday until Sunday evening.

- JST/OLT small changes in 3.3, 4.2, 4.6, 4.7, 6.9, 6.10,

## Penalty points for OLT, JST, CETSC and CEEC \*

Incorrect	<b>Penalty points</b>
Chassis	10 per leg
Engine	10 per leg
Front fork	10 per leg
Rear Shocks	10 per leg
Flat slide	5 per leg
Reed valve	5 per leg
Numberplate	3 per leg

<sup>\*</sup> For the jury to decide.

All riders with not allowed deviations must be strictly informed that participation with the deviations is accepted <u>once</u> only, and for them to carefully study actual regulations, i.e. the riders <u>cannot</u> participate with the deviation(s) in coming races.
