Dear Cemar Friends,

No changes has been made to the 2020 Cemar regulation and therefore is the 2020 regulation valid for 2022. See details in OLT, JST, Twin Shock, EVO and Super EVO regulations 2020 on <u>www.classicmx.se</u>

General

- Cemar race season 2022 will be 3 events. Jüterbog 7/5, Dall 28/5 and Linköping 13-14/8 2022
- See Race Calendar on <u>www.classicmx.se</u>

Please note that **<u>start permission is required</u>** from your local federation for Cemar races in 2022.

Rules/Regulations

- Only full face integral helmet will be FIM approved for 2022. (ECE 22-05 "P") check separate approval for SNELL and JIS-T. All helmets will be checked at technical inspection at the Cemar races.
- New Super EVO class see regulation.
- Min age for all classes is now according to riders license.
- JST class is changed to -66/66+ and Pre 74 two- and four stroke bikes. Number plate colours are changed. (See article 2. and 5.6)
- OLT only change is 72+ will use red plate.

Penalty points for all classes *

Incorrect	Penalty points
Chassis	10 per leg
Engine	10 per leg
Front fork	10 per leg
Rear Shocks	10 per leg
Flat slide	5 per leg
Reed valve	5 per leg
Numberplate	3 per leg

* For the jury to decide.

All riders with not allowed deviations must be strictly informed that participation with the deviations is accepted <u>once</u> only, and for them to carefully study actual regulations, i.e. the riders <u>cannot</u> participate with the deviation(s) in coming races.
